Organization Description:

Campers gain the confidence, skills, and tools to become stewards of the environment while developing a passion and appreciation for science! EcoCamps are weeklong overnight camps.

Camp Dates: July 9 – July 13, 2018

- Held at Galena Lodge yurts, 23 miles north of Ketchum, Idaho
- Campers arrive at noon on Monday and are picked up Friday afternoon at the ERC office in Ketchum
- Serves rising 5th – 6th graders
- One night of camp will be an overnight camping trip
- Campers will engage in creative explorations and adventures while discovering the wonders of the Boulder Mountains

Position Description:

- Under the supervision of EcoCamp staff, the LiT will:
 - Help facilitate games and other camp activities
 - Help provide a safe and supportive atmosphere for campers
 - Make camp a fun place to be
- The LiT will always work with a member of EcoCamp staff
- The LiT is subject to the same code of conduct as EcoCamp campers and will participate in all aspects of camp life.
- The Program Director will provide the LiT with two evaluations, one mid-way through camp and one at the end of camp.

Qualifications:

- Motivated to work with children.
- Must have a love for the outdoors.
- Demonstrate maturity to serve as a role model for younger campers.
- Strong work ethic and must take initiative to complete daily tasks without being reminded.
- Must be a rising 10th, 11th or 12th grade student.
- Preference will be given to past participants of ERC EcoCamp.
- Ability to work in a dynamic, team-oriented work environment, that at times demands flexibility.
- Ability to have fun!

Payment Information:

Cost is \$400

Confidential scholarship & payment plans available.

If you are chosen, a deposit of \$200 is required within one week of selection to secure your position. With scholarship application, a \$50 deposit is required. *Cancellation policy – once the position is filled, no refunds will be offered as we will be dependent on this commitment for camp planning.*

Qualified applicants will be selected for an informal interview as a part of the application process.
