REUSE

- Share magazine with neighbors and friends.
- Use flatware or reusable plastic items for parties (collect in a separate bin).

RECYCLE

- Compost yard and food waste.
- Take advantage of Blaine County's extensive recycling, diversion and materials recovery programs.

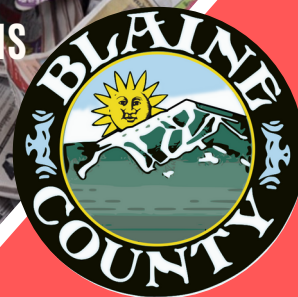
